

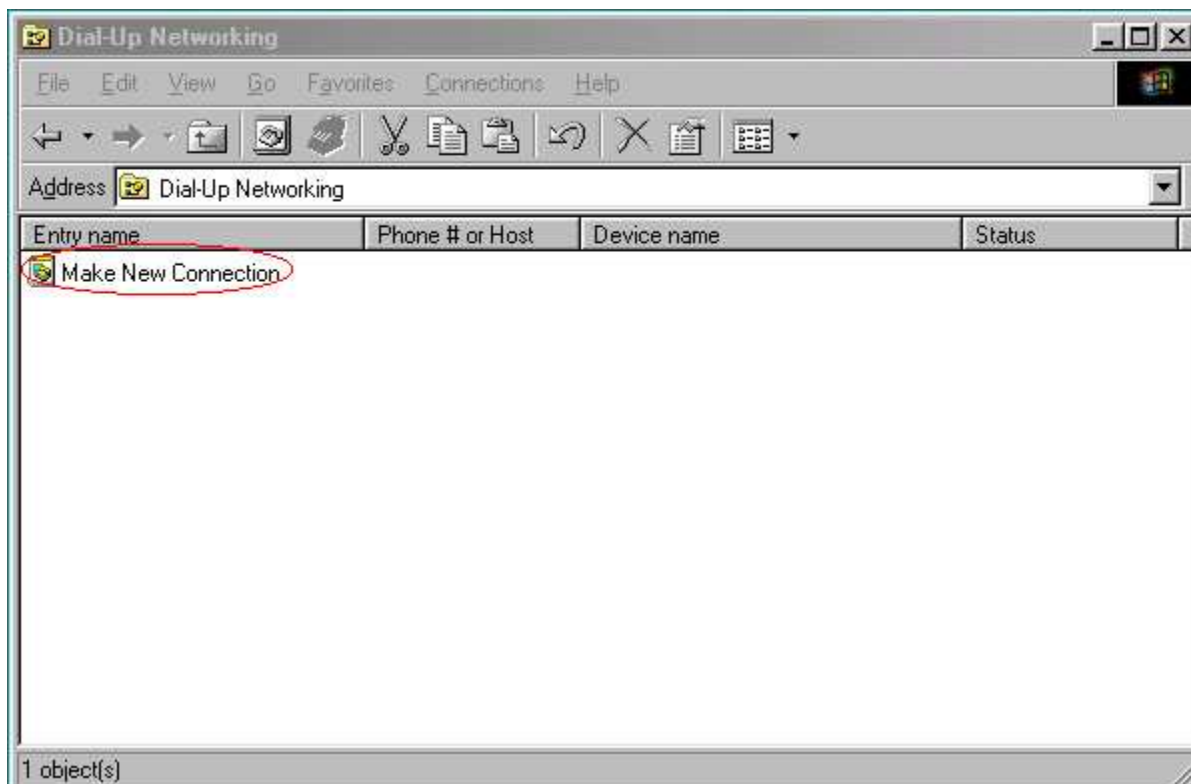
## Connecting with Windows 95 & 98 100 Mile NetShop Ltd.

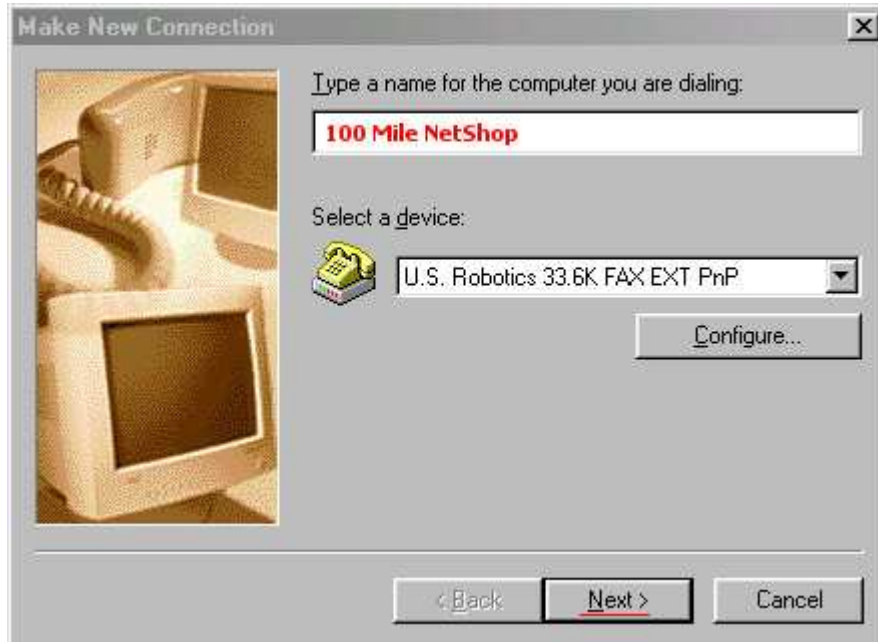
A step-by-step walkthrough

---

**1)** Open up the **Dial-Up Networking** folder from **My Computer**. Double-click the **Make New Connection** icon.



**2)** Provide a name for your connection. Replace My Connection with **100 Mile NetShop**. Then click **Next**.



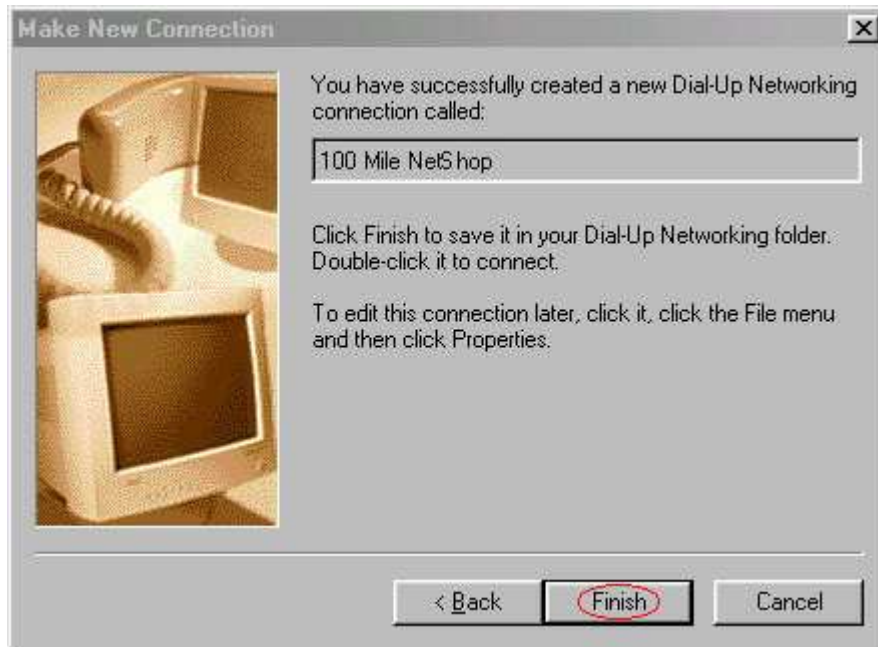

3) Enter the area code which is **250**. Type the dial-up telephone number which is **395-1925**. Select **Canada** for the country, then click **Next**.

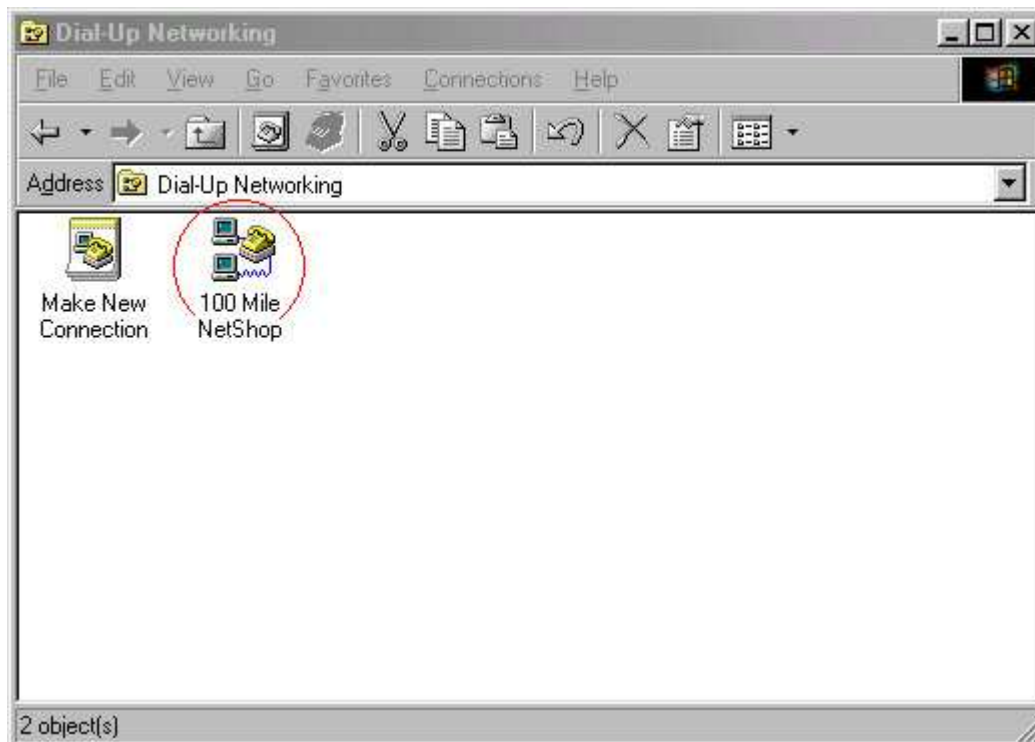

4) Press **Finish**.



5) Open **My Computer** then the **Dial-up Networking** folder. You will see the **100 Mile NetShop** connection here. For easier dialing later, you may want to create a shortcut on your desktop by right-clicking on the **100 Mile NetShop** icon and left-click on **Create Shortcut**.



6) You will then get a dialogue box that says **Windows cannot create a shortcut here. Do you want the shortcut to be placed on the desktop instead?**



**7)** Just click **yes** and it will create a **Shortcut to the 100 Mile NetShop** dial-up connection on your desktop. Anytime you want to connect after your initial set up, you can just click on this icon and you'll be on your way.
