A step-by-step walkthrough

1) On the desktop, double-click on **My Computer**. You'll see the following window.



2) Double-click on the **Dial-up Networking** link. You'll see the following window.



3) Double-click on **Make New Connection** to create a new dial-up connection icon. The box under **Type a name for the computer you are dialing** is highlighted. Enter **100 Mile NetShop** for the name. Press **Next**.



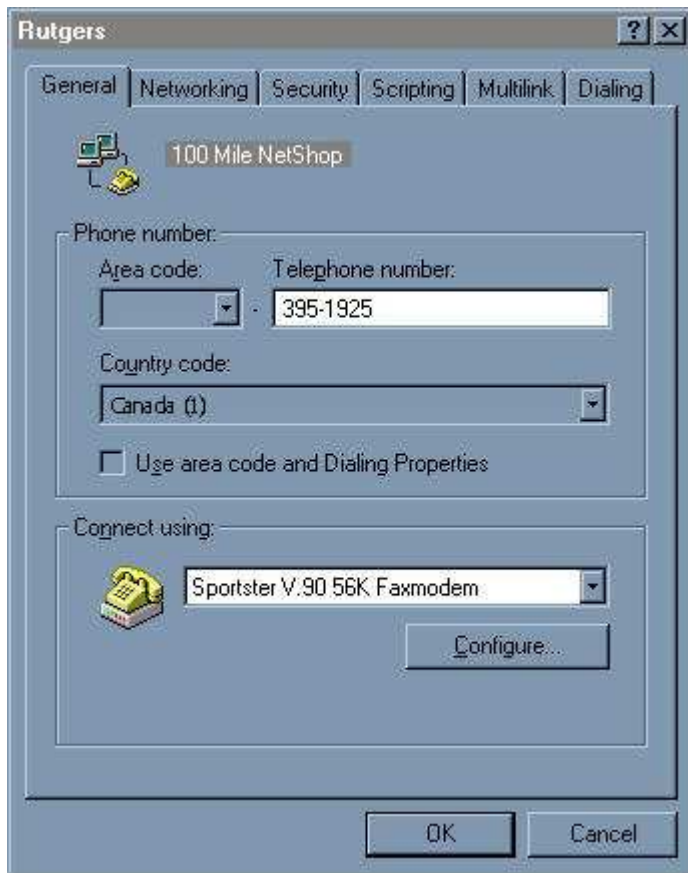
4) Enter the area code which is **250**. Type the dial-up telephone number which is **395-1925**. Select **Canada** for the country, then click **Next**, then **Finish** on the last window.



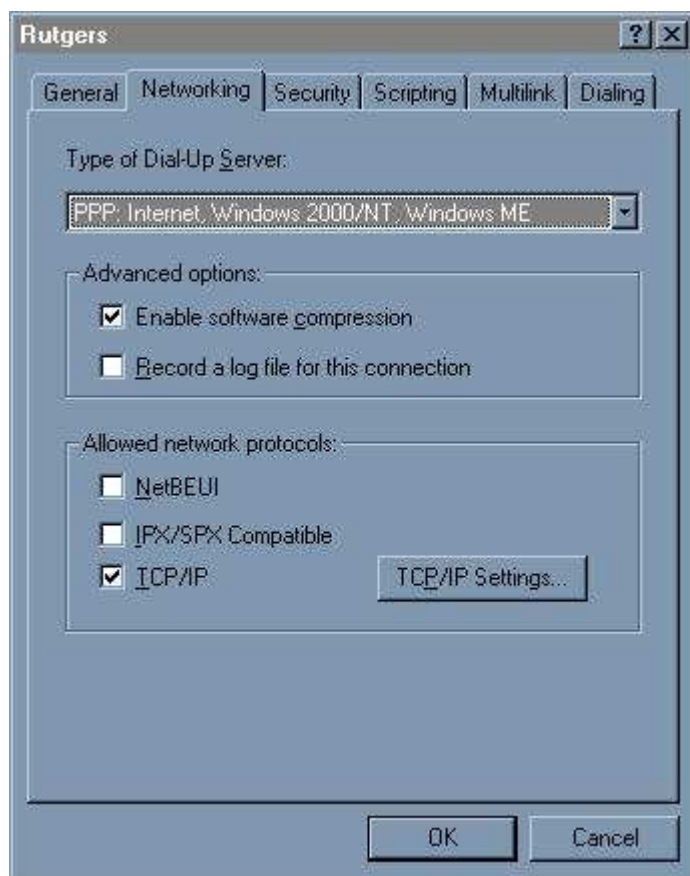
5) Right-click on the newly created icon in **Dial-up Networking**. You will see the following window.



6) Left-click on **Properties**. You'll see the following window. Un-check the **Use area code and Dialing Properties** box.



7) Click on the **Networking** tab. You should set up the screen as follows.



8) Click on **OK**. You are now back to the Dial-up Networking screen. You are now ready to dial-up and connect.
